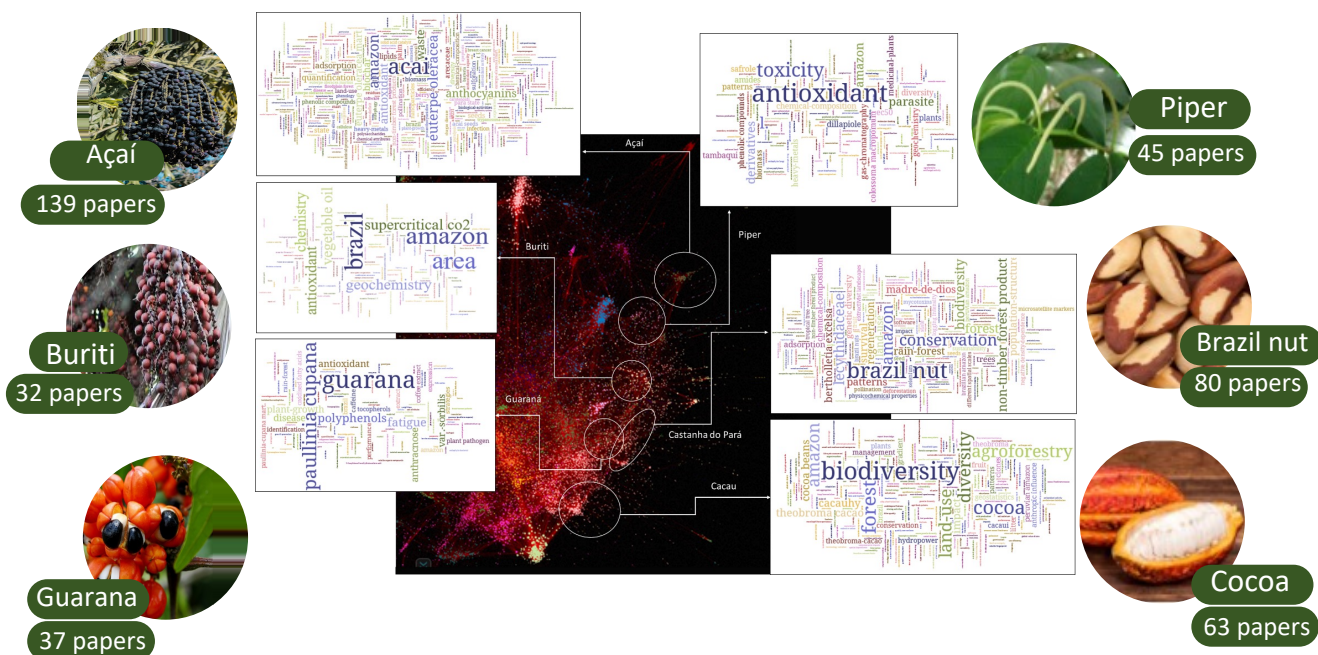
The power of socio-biodiversity

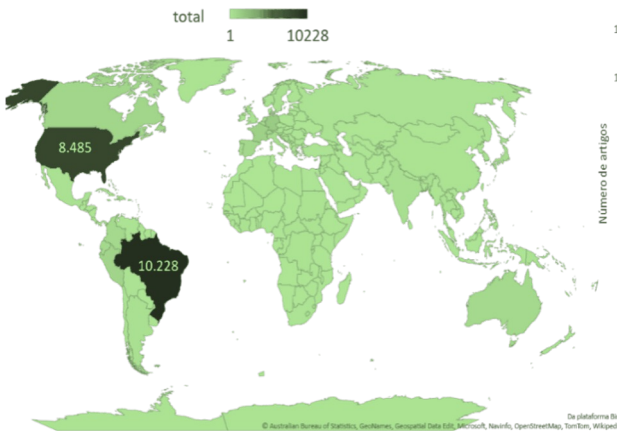
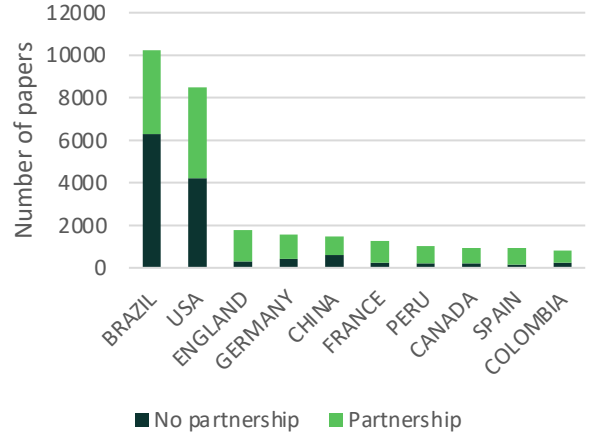
